General rules and regulations

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

1. Attendance shall be marked at the beginning of each period.

2. No student should be absent from the college without obtaining permission.

3. A student who wants leave should apply through the tutor or

Class in-charge in the prescribed application form.

4. In case of absence due to illness, furnishing of Medical

Certificate is mandatory.

5. A student who absents himself from the college any hour of the day, either in the forenoon or in the afternoon with or without leave will be considered as absent for half a day.

DISCIPLINE

1. Students should be regular to the classes.

2. Students must stand up when a faculty member enters the class and have to remain standing till they are asked to sit.

3. Students should be respectful to elders and well-mannered to all.

4. Students should be dressed in clean and respectable dresses.

5. Writing on the wall, desk or on any college assets is strictly barred.

6. Meetings of any kind shall not be held without previous written authorization from the principal.

7. Students are responsible for their personal belongings.

8. Students should make it a practice to read the notice or circulars and other papers put on view in the notice board.

9. Any belongings found in the premises should be handed over to the office with relevant particulars.

10. Change of address should be intimated to the office / Department without delay.

11. Students should park their vehicles only in the place allotted for parking.

12. Smoking as well as consuming any type of intoxicants is severely prohibited.

13. Self-discipline is expected from the students in all common places, failing in which will lead to face disciplinary action.

14. Each department has a separate dress code and students of the respective departments should wear their uniforms during functions and on Mondays.

15. Mobile phones are not allowed inside the campus. Mobile phones will be confiscated from the students if they possess them inside the college campus.

RAGGING

The Government of Tamilnadu has banned ragging in educational institutions by passing an ordinance. "Tamilnadu Prohibition of ragging act 1997" vide its orders no.7 of 1997 dated 14-02-1997 which says that indulging in ragging will be punished as follows: Imprisonment up to a term of two years, with the fine of Rs.25,000 - 2 Lakhs and students convicted for ragging will be dismissed from the institution and shall not be admitted to any other educational institutions. Hence, students are advised not to indulge in ragging, but to rise up totally against this evil. A ragging curbing committee has been constituted as per the university direction.

LIBRARY

1. The Library will be kept open on all working days from 9.00 am to 12.00 pm.

2. Silence should be strictly observed in the library.

3. Personal books, magazines, hand bags, diaries, files, boxes, umbrellas and other possessions of the users should not be brought into the library.

4. Books have to be used and handled with care. Fine will be imposed for mishandling of books.

5. Marking or underlining with pencil or pen and folding the papers for paper marks are strictly prohibited.

COMMON TESTS

1. Two common tests will be conducted during every semester.

2. Second common test will be called the model test.

3. Progress reports will be sent to the parents for corrective measures if required.

4. Frequent seminars and assignments will be given.

5. Students should write the tests and examinations sincerely.

6. The students will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before a fixed time.

TUTORIAL SYSTEM

1. About 15-20 students will be placed under a tutor.

2. Tutor will act as campus custodian of the students placed under him/her.

3. The students should always forward his/her problems or applications only through the tutor and Dean.

4. Whenever needed, the tutor shall urge inviting the parents for discussion.

PLACEMENT CELL

A separate placement cell is functioning in the college.

(5 questions - 1 each from each unit) 5x8=40

The M.B.A. students will be evaluated in 75:25 ratio. The 75 (external) marks will be awarded on the basis of performance in the End Semester Examinations (ESE). The 25 (internal) marks will be awarded in the following pattern.

Periodical Tests: 15marks

Seminars / Assignments / Class participation / Quizzes / Paper presentation / Mini project / Practical report : 10 marks (The respective faculty would choose the appropriate combinations) Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is followed.

- Students to be present inside the campus before half an hour of the commencement of the exam.
- 2. Students have to keep their Hall Tickets and ID cards before entering the Exam hall.
- 3. A Seat with Register Number will be allotted to each candidate.

- Candidate will be required to find out the specified seat and occupy the allotted seat at least minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 5. No student is allowed IN after 30 minutes / not allowed OUT before 45 minutes of the Commencement of the Examination.
- 6. Once a student left the hall, during the examination he/ she will not be allowed again to re-enter.
- 7. To write the End Semester Examination minimum 75% of attendance is mandatory.
- 8. Cell phones / electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall
- 9. Before proceeding to answer the paper, the candidate should write his/her Register Number and Subject of the Examination and date of the examination at appropriate space provided in the Answer Booklet.
